



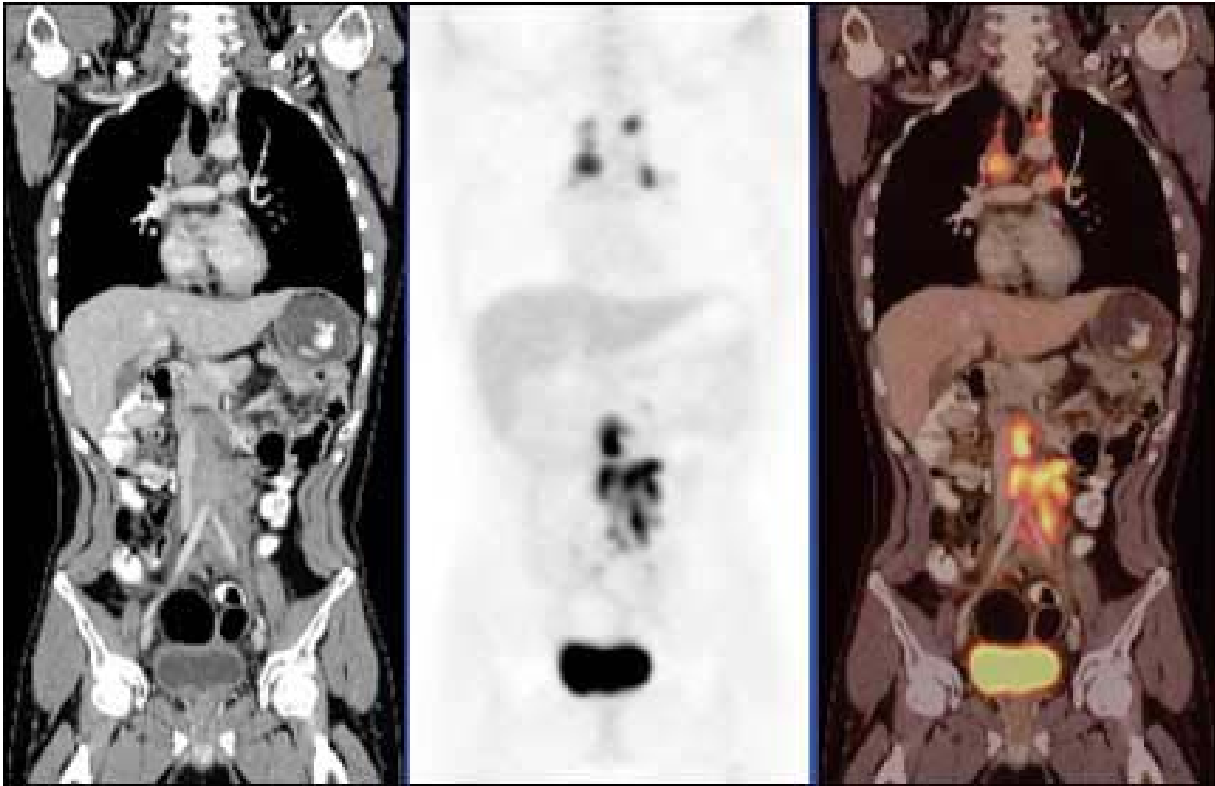

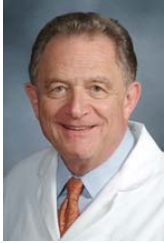

Stanley J. Goldsmith, M.D. is the Director of the Division of Nuclear Medicine, Department of Radiology at The New York Presbyterian Hospital and Professor of Radiology and Medicine at the Weill Medical College of Cornell University. Prior to this appointment, from 1992-95, Dr. Goldsmith was the Clinical Director of the Nuclear Medicine Service, Attending Radiologist and Member at the Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in New York and Professor of Radiology at the Cornell University Medical College. Dr. Goldsmith was President of the Society of Nuclear Medicine in 1985-86 and Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Nuclear Medicine from 1994-1999. He is the editor of the textbook, "Nuclear Oncology" and currently serves on the Editorial Boards of the Journal of Nuclear Medicine, and Cancer Biotherapy & Radiopharmaceuticals. He was a Director of the American Board of Nuclear Medicine from 1990-1996 and served as Treasurer of the Board from 1995-96. Dr. Goldsmith is currently Chairman of the Nuclear Medicine Section of the New York Academy of Medicine through April 2006. Dr. Goldsmith is the author of approximately 150 scientific articles, 21 book chapters, 27 invited articles and reviews and over 250 scientific abstracts.
